7.3 Paid Leave

Holidays:

- Upon hire, full-time and part-time employees are eligible to receive holiday pay on the following holidays: New Year's Day, Martin Luther King Day, Presidents' Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Pioneer Day, Labor Day, Veterans' Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, and one Floating Holiday
- 2. For each observed holiday, including the "floating" holiday, full-time employees will be paid at the regular rate of pay for the same number of hours the employee was regularly scheduled to work on that day. Holiday pay for each non-full-time employee shall be calculated by multiplying the employee's current hourly rate by the average number of hours the employee worked each day in the two pay periods immediately preceding the holiday.
- Overtime will accrue during holiday weeks on the same basis as any other week, except that employees will be credited for a day's work on the holiday without having worked.
- Holiday pay will be calculated and included in the pay period in which the holiday occurs.
- If any of the holidays, under Section 1 above, fall on a Saturday or Sunday, then the following Monday shall be the observed holiday and the District will be closed for business.

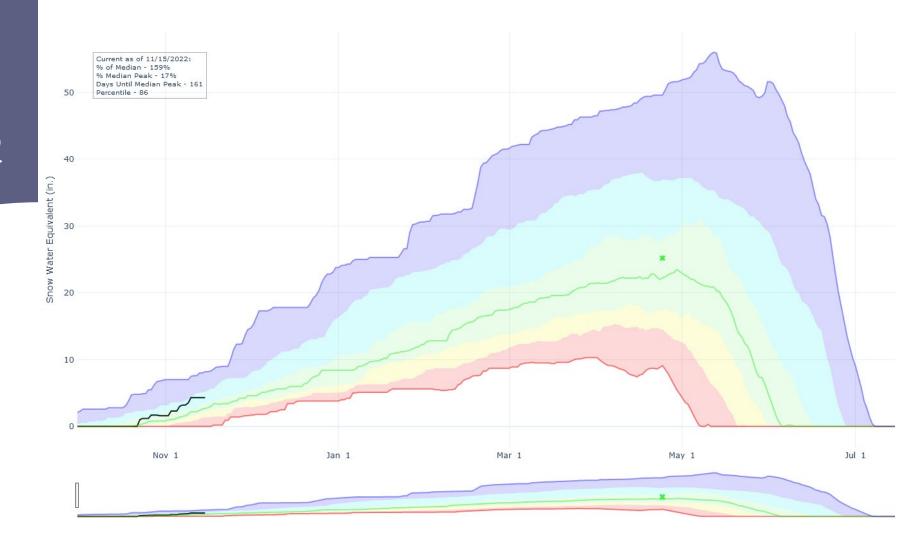

Subject: Audit Committee

Background

During the October 2022 Board meeting, the Fraud Risk Assessment (FRA) results were discussed, and it was identified that because the District does not have a formal audit committee, it was not awarded the 20 points for the Audit Committee line item. As part of the review discussion, the Board expressed an interest in pursuing the 20 points for this line item on future assessments.

Audit Committee Framework and Charter

For the District to award itself the 20 points on the FRA, the Utah State Auditor's Office gives the following guidelines:

An audit committee must ensure the following:

- 1. Management develops and enforces systems that ensure the entity accomplishes its mission effectively and efficiently while complying with laws and regulations.
- 2. The internal audit function objectively assesses the effectiveness of management's internal control program.
- Financial statement audits are performed by a qualified, independent accounting firm and issues identified during those audits are reviewed and resolved as appropriate.
- 4. Hotline complaints are investigated and findings are addressed by the governing body.

Should the Board choose to proceed in forming an audit committee to accomplish these guidelines, it is proposed that the District's Audit Committee would assume the following responsibilities:

- 1. Oversee the selection process of the independent auditor, including engaging the auditor each year to conduct the audit
- Review the results of the independent auditor's audit and audit report. After reviewing the results, the committee will present its findings to the Board and Public during a regularly scheduled board meeting.

- 3. Review and approve the annual audit plan of the internal auditor, including reviewing internal audit reports
- Review all hotline complaints and report back to the Board and Public on all complaints

District Staff also propose that the District's audit committee consist of the following members:

- 1. One board member (serve as committee chair)
- 2. General Manager
- 3. District Controller
- 4. Up to two individuals from "sister" entities who have professional financial expertise as appointed the board chair

Potential Conflict of Interests

Government Finance Officers Association offers the following best practice in reference to audit committees: "no governing body member who exercises managerial responsibilities that fall within the scope of the audit should serve as a member of the audit committee." The District Controller position could fall into the category of "exercises managerial [accounting] responsibilities." Because the District Controller could have the ability to influence the scope of internal audits, it is recommended that the District Controller recuses himself from attending any portion of audit committee meetings where the scope of internal audits are being discussed. This allows the internal auditor to maintain an "arm's length" distance between the District Controller and any internal audit. The District Controller should be present when discussing the findings of the report, so he/she can implement any internal control changes the report identifies.

In regard to the selection and engagement of the external auditor, there are fewer conflicts of interest for the District Controller, because there will be at least three other members on the audit committee that can limit how much impact the District Controller will have on the scope of the audit. However, should the audit committee want the external auditor to look at any specific areas during the external audit, the District Controller should recuse him/herself from attending that portion of the audit committee meeting.

It is recommended that the Board of Trustees update the administration policy to outline the audit committee's responsibilities and identify who would serve on the committee.

Subject: 2022 Audit Engagement with Keddington and Christensen

Background

Each year Granger-Hunter Improvement District (District) is required by state law to have an independent audit report issued to offer an opinion on the financial position of the District. In 2020, the District conducted an RFP to identify an accounting firm who would provide independent audit services for each accounting year. Keddington and Christensen was the firm who had the highest score, and the District awarded the independent audit services to them. The RFP secured pricing for a period of five years for \$11,000 for annual audit services and \$1,000 for single audit services (federal grant/loan awards). The District's 2022 Audit would be the third year subject to the five-year RFP pricing structure.

2022 Audit Engagement

Starting on January 3rd, the District needs to begin the annual audit, starting with the audit on the District's inventory. The remainder of the 2022 engagement would be performed in April, with the findings presented to the board in the May or June Board meetings.

District staff recommends that the board continue to engage the services of Keddington and Christensen to conduct the District's 2022 Audit.

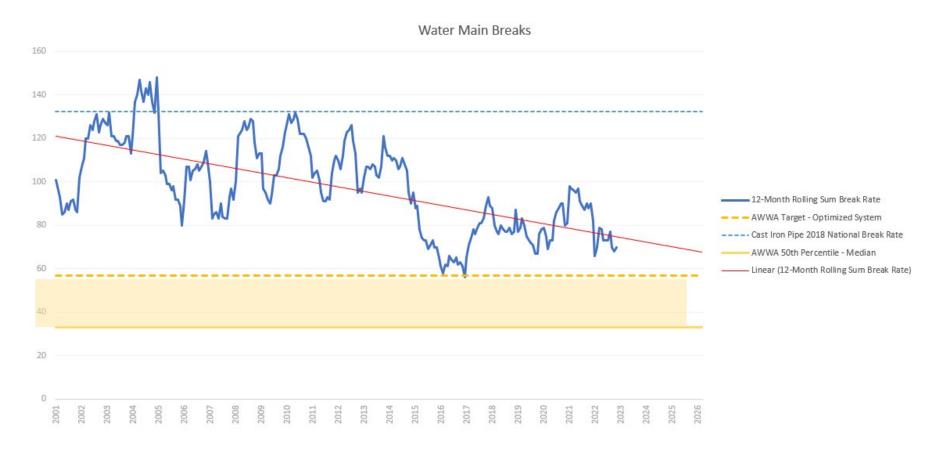

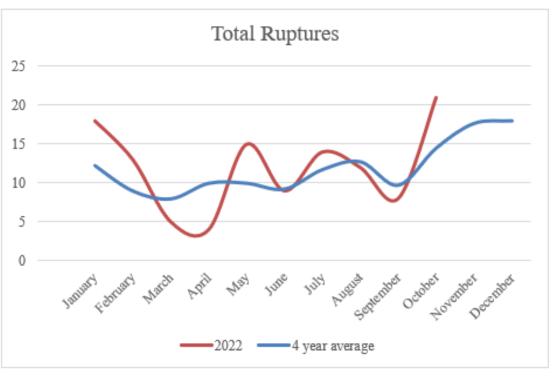

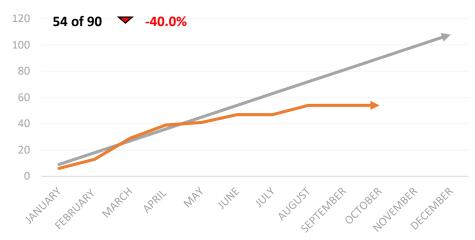
Four Year Average Trends

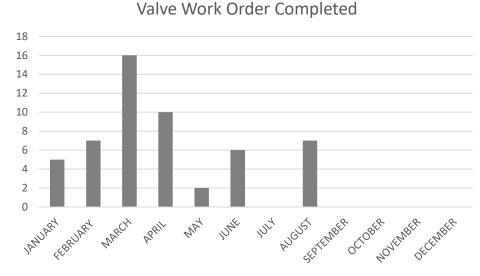

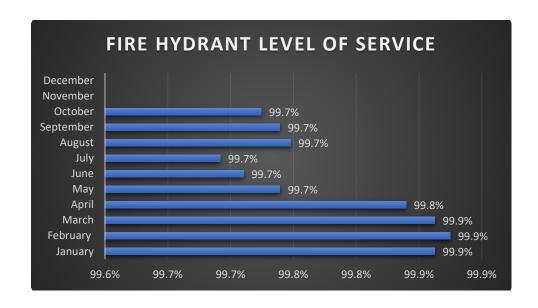


Fire Hydrant Work Order Completed

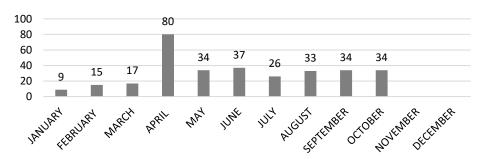

Fire Hydrant Leak Check Follow Up Inspections



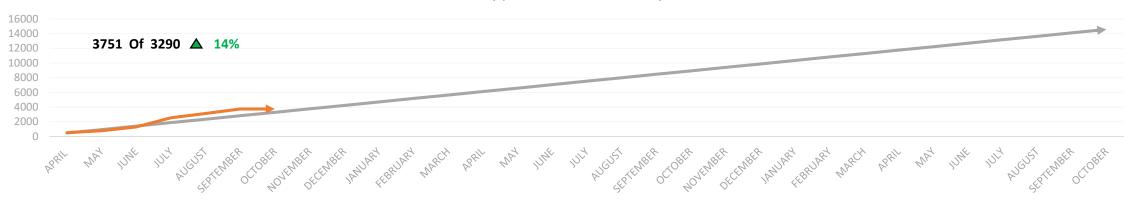
- Fire hydrant level of service (LOS). The level of service is determined by the amount of District-owned fired hydrants and how many of those were out of service for repair at any time during each month.
- Since last year's leak detection company came and identified that we have issues with leaking fire hydrants, our crews have implemented a follow-up fire hydrant inspection program. The chart on the bottom left shows the amount of fire hydrant follow-up inspections that have been completed this year. These types of inspections originate from our own crew's using the fire hydrants for maintenance operations, and from the West Valley City Fire Department's use of fire hydrants when putting out house fires. The inspections contain a brief inspection of the fire hydrant to ensure it has been properly shut down and to make sure that the fire hydrant is still operating correctly.



2022 Data:

■ In the month of March, the water maintenance group was tasked with assisting in the Lead & Copper identification program that must be completed by October 2024. The target below is based on the total amount of unidentified connections, 14,535, and the completion deadline. The District has determined that if we identify 470 per month, we will reach our goal of identifying all unidentified service lines by the October 2024 deadline.

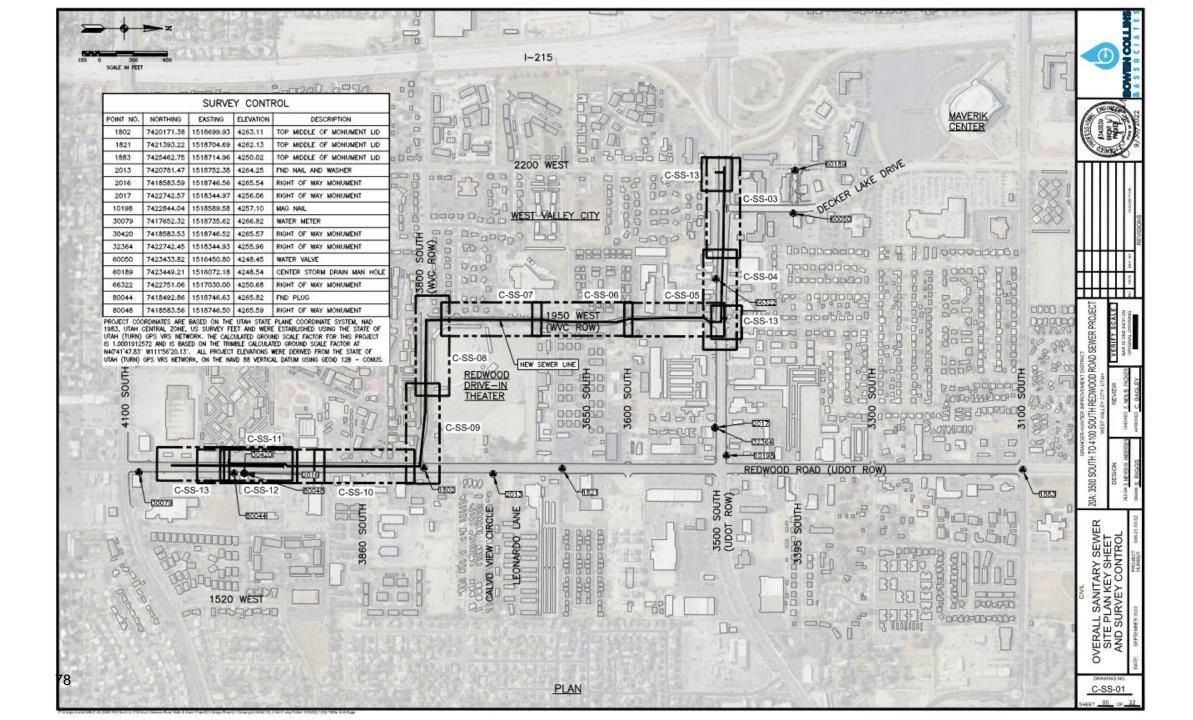


10-year Capacity



Build-out Capacity





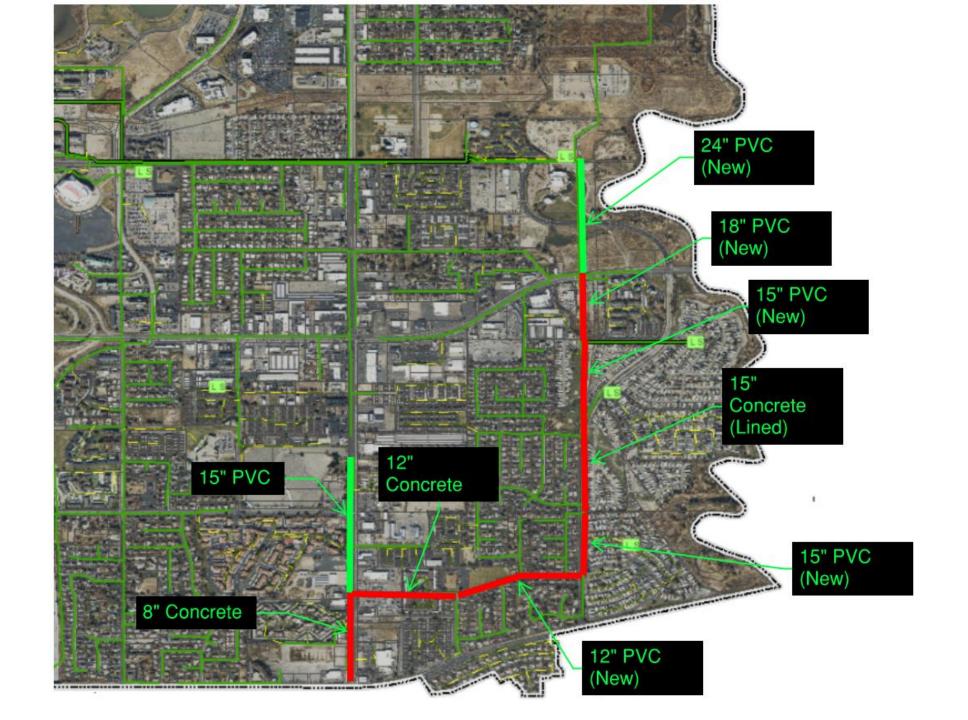

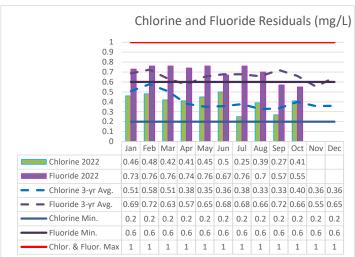
CAPITAL PROJECTS MAP



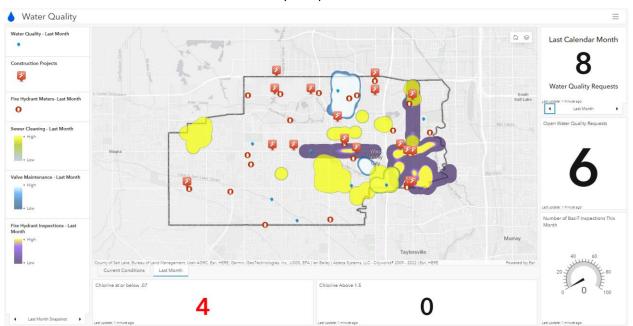






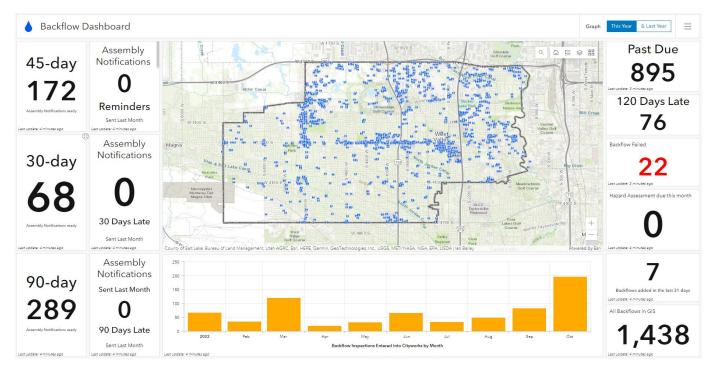


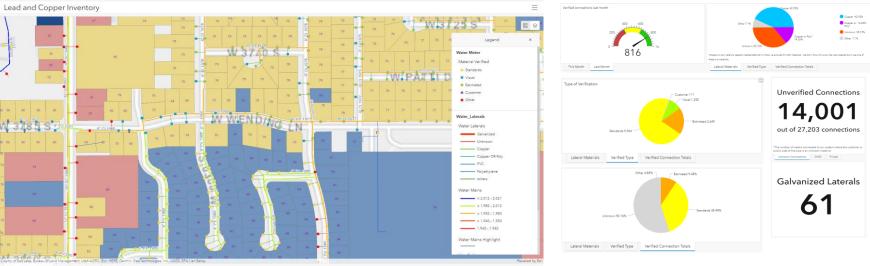
Water Quality Complaint Locations - October
